

CALACT 2018 AUTUMN CONFERENCE GROUP HIKE

Bothe-Napa Valley State Park
Calistoga, CA



Join your CALACT friends for a group trek along the Ritchey Canyon Trail to Coyote Peak in Bothe SP. This hike features creeks, redwoods, and views of the Napa Valley.

This is a moderate loop hike with over 1,100 feet of elevation gains over 5+miles of distance. The area itself features many corresponding trails should you wish to shorten the trek.

\$25/per person.

Water, granola bars, transportation passes for NVTa, and a commemorative gift will be provided. Proceeds go to the RTAP scholarship fund.

Hikers will meet in the hotel lobby at 10:00 AM on Monday, November 12th, and walk a short distance to the Redwoods Park 'N Ride to catch the #10 bus at 10:30 AM. The bus will reach BNVSP at approximately 11:10 AM. The hike will take approximately 3 hours - should hikers wish to leave earlier, they can take the SB #10 bus back, which leaves at 00:30 every hour.

The area has poison oak as well as rattlesnakes and coyotes - hikers are advised to remain cautious of surroundings and dress appropriately. The trail has technical challenges such as narrow stream crossings, varied elevation gains, and narrow paths - this outing is not suggested for inexperienced hikers.
