Beach Cities Transit
Transit Services Study

The City of Redondo Beach ["City"] is requesting proposals for a Transit Services Study of the public transit services operated by the City as Beach Cities Transit. These services presently include the fixed route services operated as Beach Cities Transit and the WAVE Dial-A-Ride.

The City expects the selected Consultant to thoroughly assess and evaluate the current Beach Cities Transit service program in the context of the present and projected future operating, financial, and environmental conditions and to recommend short-range (3-5 year) operational changes and improvements and long-range (5-15 year) strategic direction to guide the City's decisions regarding public transit services and related capital investments.

Proposals will be received by the City Clerk of the City of Redondo Beach, 415 Diamond Street, Door 1, Redondo Beach, California, until 2:00 p.m. PDT on December 2, 2021. An optional virtual pre-proposal conference is scheduled for 10:30 a.m., Tuesday, November 2, 2021, via Microsoft Teams videoconference; Proposers should contact the City at bct@redondo.org if they intend to attend the meeting to receive video conference meeting invite by November 1, 2021. Responding individuals will be emailed a Microsoft Teams invitation to participate in the Pre-Proposal Meeting no later than 5:00 PM Tuesday, November 1, 2021.

Proposals received after specified date and time will be considered late and returned to the proposer unopened. Each proposal shall include the forms provided in the RFP, and shall be submitted complete, in accordance with the RFP in a sealed package with the proposal number and the name and address of the proposer appearing on the outside of the package. Proposals submitted by telephone, fax, or electronic mail will not be accepted. The City of Redondo Beach reserves the right to reject any and all proposals received and, to the extent permitted by law, to waive any irregularities in any proposal.
